

Safe Log Splitter Use Checklist

- Wear safety glasses, gloves, and steel-toed boots.
 - Operate in a level, stable area.
 - Remove any trip hazards from the work area.
 - Check oil and fuel levels of the log splitter.
 - Inspect the hydraulic system for leaks and damage.
 - Make sure the log splitter is well-ventilated, outdoors.
 - Firmly secure the log before splitting.
 - Never place hands near the wedge while splitting.
 - Use both hands on the controls during operation.
 - Clear away split wood before placing the next log.
 - Stop the engine before refueling.
 - When finished, turn off the engine and disconnect the spark plug wire.
